- Who was John?

John 21:24

24 This is the disciple who is bearing witness about these things, and who has written these things, and **we know that his testimony is true.**

25 Now there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.

John 20:30

The Purpose of This Book

30 Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written **so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God**, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

John 13:23

23 One of his disciples, whom Jesus loved, was reclining at table at Jesus' side
