

The Sermon On The Mount
Family Prayer Time
Matthew 6:5-13

Matthew 5:3 “Blessed are the **poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**

Matthew 5:20 For I tell you, unless your **righteousness exceeds** that of the scribes and Pharisees, **you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.**

Matthew 6:5 “And **when you pray**, you must **not be like the hypocrites.** For they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, **that they may be seen by others.** Truly, I say to you, **they have received their reward.**

Do not be like the hypocrites...they pray to be seen not heard.

Matthew 6:6 But **when you pray**, go into your room and shut the door and **pray to your Father who is in secret.** And **your Father who sees in secret** will reward you.

Matthew 6:7 “And **when you pray**, do not heap up **empty phrases** as the **Gentiles** do, for **they think that they will be heard for their many words.**

1Kings 18:24 And **you call upon the name of your god**, and **I will call upon the name of the LORD**, and **the God who answers by fire, he is God.**” And all the people answered, “It is well spoken.”

1Kings 18:25 Then Elijah said to the prophets of Baal, “Choose for yourselves one bull and prepare it first, for you are many, and **call upon the name of your god**, but put no fire to it.”

1Kings 18:26 And they took the bull that was given them, and they prepared it and **called upon the name of Baal from morning until noon**, saying, “O Baal, answer us!” **But there was no voice, and no one answered.** And they limped around the altar that they had made.

1Kings 18:27 And at noon Elijah mocked them, saying, “Cry aloud, for he is a god. Either he is musing, or he is relieving himself, or he is on a journey, or perhaps he is asleep and must be awakened.”

1Kings 18:28 And **they cried aloud** and **cut themselves** after their custom with swords and lances, until the blood gushed out upon them.

1Kings 18:29 And as midday passed, **they raved on** until the time of the offering of the oblation, **but there was no voice. No one answered; no one paid attention.**

Do not be like the Gentiles...they pray to be heard but it doesn't work.

Matthew 6:8 **Do not be like them**, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Matthew 6:9 **Pray then like this:** “**Our Father** in heaven, **hallowed be your name.**

Matthew 6:10 **Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.**

Matthew 6:11 **Give us** this day our daily bread,

Matthew 6:12 and **forgive us** our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

Matthew 6:13 And **lead us** not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Matthew 6:8-9a Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Pray then like this: “**Our Father...**

John 1:12 But to all who did **receive him**, who **believed in his name**, **he gave the right to become children of God,**

Ephesians 1:5 he predestined us for **adoption as sons through Jesus Christ**, according to the purpose of his will,

1John 3:1 See what kind of **love the Father has given to us**, that we should be called **children of God; and so we are**. The reason why the world does not know us is that it did not know him.

Galatians 3:26 for in Christ Jesus **you are all sons of God, through faith**.

Galatians 4:4 But when the fullness of time had come, **God sent** forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,

Galatians 4:5 **to redeem** those who were under the law, **so that we might receive adoption as sons**.

Galatians 4:6 And **because you are sons, God has sent** the Spirit of his Son **into our hearts**, crying, **“Abba! Father!”**

Galatians 4:7 So you are no longer a slave, **but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God**.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then with **confidence draw near** to the throne of grace, that we may receive **mercy and find grace to help in time of need**.

Luke 15:19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son. **Treat me as one of your hired servants.”**

Matthew 18:3 and said, “Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, **you will never enter the kingdom of heaven**.

Matthew 18:4 Whoever **humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven**.

Mark 10:15 Truly, I say to you, whoever does not **receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it.”**

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. **No one comes to the Father except through me**.

John 15:9 **As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you.** Abide in my love.

John 16:26 In that day you will ask in my name, and **I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf;**

John 16:27 **for the Father himself loves you,** because **you have loved me** and have **believed that I came from God.**

John 17:25 O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.

John 17:26 **I made known to them your name,** and **I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them,** and I in them.”



Luke 11:5 And he said to them, “Which of you who has a **friend** will go to him at midnight and say to him, ‘Friend, lend me three loaves,

Luke 11:6 for a **friend** of mine has arrived on a journey, and I have nothing to set before him’;

Luke 11:7 and he will answer from within, ‘**Do not bother me**; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed. I cannot get up and give you anything’?

Luke 11:8 I tell you, **though he will not get up and give him anything because he is his friend**, yet because of his **impudence** he will rise and give him whatever he needs.

Luke 11:9 And **I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.**
