

## Romans 8:32 • Spare, Gave, Give

Romans 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? **If God is for us, who can be against us?**

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, **how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?**

Romans 1:6 including **you who are called to belong to Jesus Christ,**

Romans 1:7 **To all those** in Rome **who are loved by God** and **called to be saints:** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 8:32 He (Father) who did not spare his own Son (Jesus) but gave him (Jesus) up for us (called to belong to Jesus Christ, who are loved by God, called to be saints) all, how will he (Father) not also with him (Jesus) graciously give us (called to belong to Jesus Christ, who are loved by God, called to be saints) all things?

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has **blessed us in Christ** with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 1:4 even as he (God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ) chose us in him (Jesus) **before the foundation of the world**, that we should be holy and blameless before him. **In love**

Ephesians 1:5 **he predestined** us for adoption as sons **through Jesus Christ**, according to the **purpose of his will**,

Ephesians 1:6 to **the praise of his glorious grace**, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

## before the foundation of the world

John 2:4 And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does this have to do with me? **My hour has not yet come.**”

John 7:30 So they were seeking to arrest him, but no one laid a hand on him, because **his hour had not yet come.**

John 8:20 These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, **because his hour had not yet come.**

John 12:27 “Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour’? **But for this purpose I have come to this hour.**

John 17:1 When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, “**Father, the hour has come;** glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you,

Matthew 26:37 And taking with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, **he began to be sorrowful and troubled.**

Matthew 26:38 Then he said to them, “**My soul is very sorrowful, even to death;** remain here, and watch with me.”

Matthew 26:39 And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, “**My Father,** if it be possible, **let this cup pass from me;** nevertheless, **not as I will, but as you will.**”

Hebrews 5:7 In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with **loud cries and tears, to him who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence.**

Luke 22:43 And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, **strengthening him.**

Luke 22:44 And **being in an agony he prayed more earnestly;** and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

Matthew 26:42 Again, for the second time, he went away and prayed, “My Father, **if this cannot pass unless I drink it**, your will be done.”

Matthew 26:44 So, leaving them again, he went away and prayed for the **third time, saying the same words again.**

Matthew 26:45 Then he came to the disciples and said to them, “Sleep and take your rest later on. See, **the hour is at hand**, and **the Son of Man is betrayed** into the hands of sinners.

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave (betrayed) him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

*paradidōmi* - to give over, hand over, deliver up

Matthew 26:46 Rise, let us be going; see, **my betrayer is at hand.**”

John 8:42 Jesus said to them, “If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of **my own accord, but he sent me.**

John 10:18 **No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord.** I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. **This charge I have received from my Father.**”

John 14:29 And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe.

John 14:30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. **He has no claim on me,**

John 14:31 but **I do as the Father has commanded me**, so that the world may know that **I love the Father.** Rise, let us go from here.

John 18:4 Then Jesus, **knowing all that would happen to him**, came forward and said to them, **“Whom do you seek?”**

John 18:8 Jesus answered, **“I told you that I am he. So, if you seek me, let these men go.”**

John 18:9 This was to fulfill the word that he had spoken: **“Of those whom you gave me I have lost not one.”**

Philippians 2:8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming **obedient to the point of death**, even death on a cross.

Hebrews 12:2 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who **for the joy that was set before him endured the cross**, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Acts 4:27 for truly in this city **there were gathered together against your holy servant Jesus**, whom you anointed, **both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel**,

Acts 4:28 **to do whatever your hand and your plan had predestined to take place.**

Isaiah 53:10 **Yet it was the will of the Lord to crush him**; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, **he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the Lord shall prosper in his hand.**

Isaiah 53:11 **Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied**; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, **make many to be accounted righteous**, and **he shall bear their iniquities.**

John 14:31 but I do as the **Father** has commanded me, so that the world may know that I **love the Father**. Rise, let us go from here.

Matthew 26:53 **Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels?**

Matthew 26:54 But how then should the Scriptures be fulfilled, that **it must be so?**”

Matthew 26:57 Then those who had **seized Jesus led him** to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders had gathered.

Matthew 26:66 What is your judgment?” They answered, “He deserves death.”

Matthew 26:67 Then **they spit in his face and struck him**. And some **slapped him**,

Matthew 26:68 saying, “Prophecy to us, you Christ! Who is it that struck you?”

Matthew 27:2 And **they bound him and led him away and delivered him over** to Pilate the governor.

Matthew 27:26 Then he released for them Barabbas, and having **scourged Jesus, delivered him to be crucified**.

Matthew 27:27 Then the soldiers of the governor **took Jesus into the governor’s headquarters**, and they gathered the whole battalion before him.

Matthew 27:28 And **they stripped him** and put a scarlet robe on him,

Matthew 27:29 and twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on his head and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!”

Matthew 27:30 And **they spit on him** and took the reed and **struck him on the head**.

Matthew 27:31 And when they had mocked him, **they stripped him** of the robe and put his own clothes on him and **led him away** to crucify him.

Matthew 27:35 And when **they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots.**

Matthew 27:36 Then they sat down and **kept watch over him** there.

Matthew 27:39 And **those who passed by derided him**, wagging their heads

Matthew 27:40 and saying, “You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself! **If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross.”**

Matthew 27:41 So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, **mocked him**, saying,

Matthew 27:42 “**He saved others; he cannot save himself.** He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him.

Matthew 27:43 **He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, ‘I am the Son of God.’”**

Matthew 27:44 And **the robbers** who were crucified with him **also reviled him in the same way.**

Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” that is, “**My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?**”

Matthew 27:50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit.

John 19:30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, “**It is finished,**” and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Revelation 13:8 and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the **book of life of the Lamb who was slain.**

Isaiah 46:10 declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, '**My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,**'

Ephesians 3:11 This was according to the **eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord,**
