Gospel According to Daniel

2Peter 3:8 But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord **one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day**.

Isaiah 46:9b ...for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me,

Isaiah 46:10 declaring the **end from the beginning** and from ancient times **things not yet done**, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,'

Daniel 2:1 In the **second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar**, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; his spirit was troubled, and his sleep left him.

Daniel 2:2 Then the king commanded that the magicians, the enchanters, the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans be summoned to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king.

Daniel 2:3 And the king said to them, "I had a dream, and my spirit is troubled to know the dream."

Daniel 2:4 Then the Chaldeans said to the king in Aramaic, "O king, live forever! **Tell your servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation."**

Daniel 2:5 The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, "The word from me is firm: if you do not make known to me the dream and its interpretation, you shall be torn limb from limb, and your houses shall be laid in ruins.

Daniel 2:6 **But if you show the dream** and **its interpretation**, you shall receive from me **gifts** and **rewards** and **great honor**. Therefore show me the dream and its interpretation."

Daniel 2:7 They answered a second time and said, "Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will show its interpretation."

Daniel 2:8 The king answered and said, "I know with certainty that you are trying to gain time, because you see that the word from me is firm—

- Daniel 2:9 if you do not make the dream known to me, there is but one sentence for you. You have agreed to speak lying and corrupt words before me till the times change. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can show me its interpretation."
- Daniel 2:10 The Chaldeans answered the king and said, "**There is not a man on earth** who can meet the king's demand, for no great and powerful king has asked such a thing of any magician or enchanter or Chaldean.
- Daniel 2:11 The thing that the king asks is difficult, and **no one can show it to the king except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh.**"
- John 1:14 And the **Word became flesh** and **dwelt among us**, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- Daniel 2:12 Because of this the king was angry and very furious, and commanded that all the wise men of Babylon be destroyed.
- Daniel 2:13 So the decree went out, and the wise men were about to be killed; and they sought Daniel and his companions, to kill them.
- Daniel 2:14 Then Daniel replied with prudence and discretion to Arioch, the captain of the king's guard, who had gone out to **kill the wise men** of Babylon.
- Daniel 2:15 He declared to Arioch, the king's captain, "Why is the decree of the king so urgent?" Then Arioch made the matter known to Daniel.
- Daniel 2:16 And Daniel went in and requested the king to appoint him a time, that he might show the interpretation to the king.
- Daniel 2:17 Then Daniel went to his house and made the matter known to **Hananiah**, **Mishael**, and **Azariah**, his companions,
- Daniel 2:18 and told them to **seek mercy from the God** of heaven concerning this mystery, so that Daniel and his companions might not be destroyed with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.
- Daniel 2:19 **Then the mystery was revealed to Daniel in a vision** of the night. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

- Daniel 2:20 Daniel answered and said: "Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, to whom belong wisdom and might.
- Daniel 2:21 **He changes times** and **seasons**; **he removes** kings and **sets up** kings; **he gives wisdom** to the wise and **knowledge** to those who have understanding;
- Daniel 2:22 **he reveals deep** and **hidden things**; **he knows** what is in the darkness, and the **light dwells with him.**
- Daniel 2:23 To you, O God of my fathers, I give thanks and praise, for you have given me wisdom and might, and have now **made known to me what we asked of you,** for you have made known to us the king's matter."
- Daniel 2:24 Therefore Daniel went in to Arioch, whom the king had appointed to destroy the wise men of Babylon. He went and said thus to him: "Do not destroy the wise men of Babylon; bring me in before the king, and I will show the king the interpretation."
- Daniel 2:25 Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste and said thus to him: "I have found among the exiles from Judah a man who will make known to the king the interpretation."
- Daniel 2:26 The king declared to Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, "**Are you able** to make known to me the dream that I have seen and its interpretation?"
- Daniel 2:27 Daniel answered the king and said, "No wise men, enchanters, magicians, or astrologers can show to the king the mystery that the king has asked,
- Daniel 2:28 but there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries, and he has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what will be in the latter days. Your dream and the visions of your head as you lay in bed are these:
- Daniel 2:29 To you, O king, as you lay in bed came thoughts of what would be after this, and he who reveals mysteries made known to you what is to be.
- Daniel 2:30 But as for me, this mystery has been revealed to me, **not because of any wisdom that I have more than all the living**, but in order that the interpretation may be made known to the king, and that you may know the thoughts of your mind.

Daniel 2:31 "You saw, O king, and behold, a **great image**. This image, mighty and of exceeding brightness, stood before you, and its appearance was frightening.

Daniel 2:32 The head of this image was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its middle and thighs of bronze,

Daniel 2:33 its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay.

Daniel 2:34 As you looked, a stone was cut out by no human hand, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces.

Daniel 2:35 Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, all together were broken in pieces, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, so that not a trace of them could be found. But the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

Romans 9:33 as it is written, "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense; and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame."

Daniel 2:36 "This was the dream. Now we will tell the king its interpretation...

Medo-Persia, Greece and Roman empires

Daniel 2:44 And in the days of those kings the **God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed**, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, and **it shall stand forever**,

Daniel 2:47 The king answered and said to Daniel, "Truly, **your God is God of gods and Lord of kings**, and a revealer of mysteries, for you have been able to reveal this mystery."

Daniel 2:48 Then the king gave Daniel high honors and many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon and chief prefect over all the wise men of Babylon.

Daniel 2:49 Daniel made a request of the king, and he appointed Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego over the affairs of the province of Babylon. But Daniel remained at the king's court.

- Daniel 3:1 **King Nebuchadnezzar made an image of gold**, whose height was sixty cubits (90 ft.) and its breadth six cubits (9 ft.). He set it up on the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.
- Daniel 3:2 Then King Nebuchadnezzar sent to gather the satraps, the prefects, and the governors, the counselors, the treasurers, the justices, the magistrates, and all the officials of the provinces to come to the **dedication of the image that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up.**
- Daniel 3:3 Then the satraps, the prefects, and the governors, the counselors, the treasurers, the justices, the magistrates, and all the officials of the provinces gathered for the dedication of the image that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up. And they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.
- Daniel 3:4 And the **herald proclaimed** aloud, "**You are commanded**, O peoples, nations, and languages,
- Daniel 3:5 that when you hear the sound of the horn, pipe, lyre, trigon, harp, bagpipe, and every kind of music, you are to fall down and worship the golden image that King Nebuchadnezzar has set up.
- Daniel 3:6 And whoever does not fall down and worship shall immediately be cast into a burning fiery furnace."
- Daniel 3:7 **Therefore**, as soon as all the peoples heard the sound of the horn, pipe, lyre, trigon, harp, bagpipe, and every kind of music, **all the peoples**, nations, and languages **fell down and worshiped the golden image that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up....**
- Daniel 3:12 There are certain Jews whom you have appointed over the affairs of the province of Babylon: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. These men, O king, pay no attention to you; they do not serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up."
- Daniel 3:13 Then Nebuchadnezzar in furious rage commanded that Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego be brought. So they brought these men before the king.

- Daniel 3:14 Nebuchadnezzar answered and said to them, "Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the golden image that I have set up?
- Daniel 3:15 Now if you are ready when you hear the sound of the horn, pipe, lyre, trigon, harp, bagpipe, and every kind of music, to fall down and worship the image that I have made, well and good. But if you do not worship, you shall immediately be cast into a burning fiery furnace. And who is the god who will deliver you out of my hands?"
- Daniel 3:16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter.
- Daniel 3:17 If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king.
- Daniel 3:18 But if not, be it known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up."
- Daniel 3:19 Then Nebuchadnezzar was filled with fury, and the expression of his face was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. He ordered the furnace heated seven times more than it was usually heated.
- Daniel 3:20 And he ordered some of the mighty men of his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast them into the burning fiery furnace.
- Daniel 3:21 Then these men were bound in their cloaks, their tunics, their hats, and their other garments, and they were thrown into the burning fiery furnace.
- Daniel 3:22 Because the king's order was urgent and the furnace overheated, the flame of the fire killed those men who took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.
- Daniel 3:23 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, **fell bound into the burning fiery furnace.**
- Daniel 3:24 **Then King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished** and rose up in haste. He declared to his counselors, "**Did we not cast three men bound into the fire?**" They answered and said to the king, "True, O king."

Daniel 3:25 He answered and said, "But I see four men unbound, walking in the midst of the fire, and they are not hurt; and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods."

Daniel 3:26 Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the door of the burning fiery furnace; he declared, "Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, servants of the Most High God, come out, and come here!" Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego came out from the fire.

Daniel 3:27 And the satraps, the prefects, the governors, and the king's counselors gathered together and saw that the fire had not had any power over the bodies of those men. The hair of their heads was not singed, their cloaks were not harmed, and no smell of fire had come upon them.

Daniel 3:28 Nebuchadnezzar answered and said, "Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who has sent his angel and **delivered his servants, who trusted in him**, and **set aside the king's command**, and **yielded up their bodies rather than serve and worship any god except their own God.**

Daniel 3:29 Therefore I make a decree: Any people, nation, or language that speaks anything against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego shall be torn limb from limb, and their houses laid in ruins, for there is no other god who is able to rescue in this way."

Daniel 7:13 "I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came **one like a son of man**, and **he came to the Ancient of Days** and was presented before him.

Daniel 7:14 And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

Daniel 7:21 As I looked, this horn made war with the saints and prevailed over them,

Daniel 7:22 <u>until</u> the **Ancient of Days came**, and judgment was given for the saints of the Most High, and the **time came when the saints possessed the kingdom...**

Daniel 7:27 And the kingdom and the dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven **shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High;** his kingdom **shall be an everlasting kingdom**, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.'...

Daniel 9:20 While I was speaking and praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my plea before the LORD my God for the holy hill of my God,

Daniel 9:21 while I was speaking in prayer, **the man Gabriel**, whom I had seen in the vision at the first, came to me in swift flight at the time of the evening sacrifice.

Daniel 9:22 He made me understand, speaking with me and saying, "O Daniel, I have now come out to give you **insight and understanding.**

Daniel 9:23 At the beginning of your **pleas for mercy** a word went out, and I have come to tell it to you, **for you are greatly loved**. Therefore consider the word and **understand the vision**.

Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, **to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity**, to bring in **everlasting righteousness**, to seal both vision and prophet, and to anoint a most holy place.

Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to **the coming of an anointed one, a prince**, there shall be seven weeks. Then for sixty-two weeks it shall be built again with squares and moat, but in a troubled time.

Daniel 9:26 And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one shall be cut off and shall have nothing....

Matthew 26:63 But Jesus remained silent. And the high priest said to him, "I adjure you by the living God, tell us if you are the Christ, the Son of God."

Matthew 26:64 Jesus said to him, "You have said so. But I tell you, from now on you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven."

Daniel 7:13 "I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came **one like a son of man**, and **he came to the Ancient of Days** and was presented before him.

Matthew 26:65 Then the high priest tore his robes and said, "He has uttered blasphemy. What further witnesses do we need? You have now heard his blasphemy.

Matthew 26:66 What is your judgment?" They answered, "He deserves death."

Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal both vision and prophet, and to anoint a most holy place.
