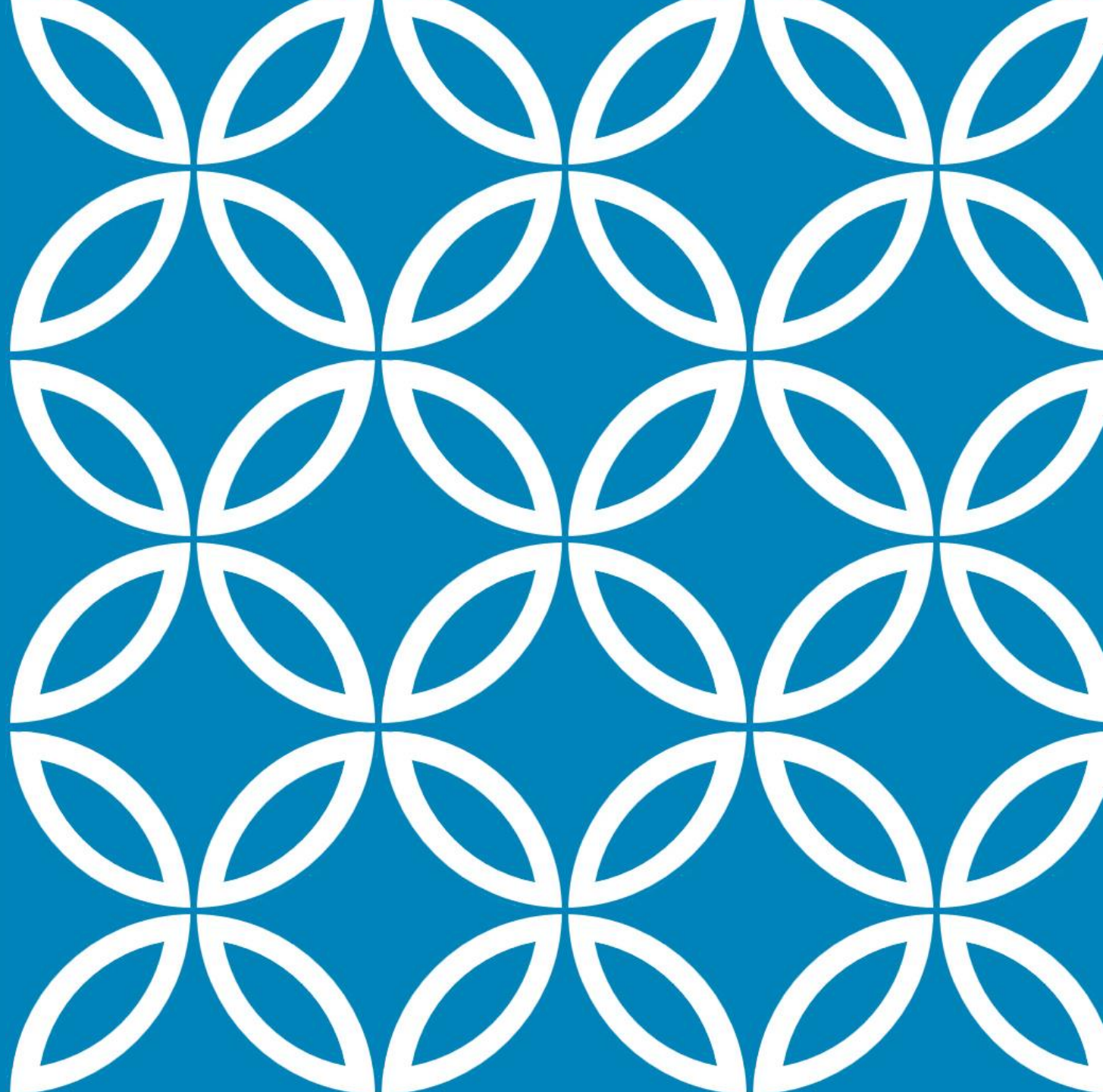

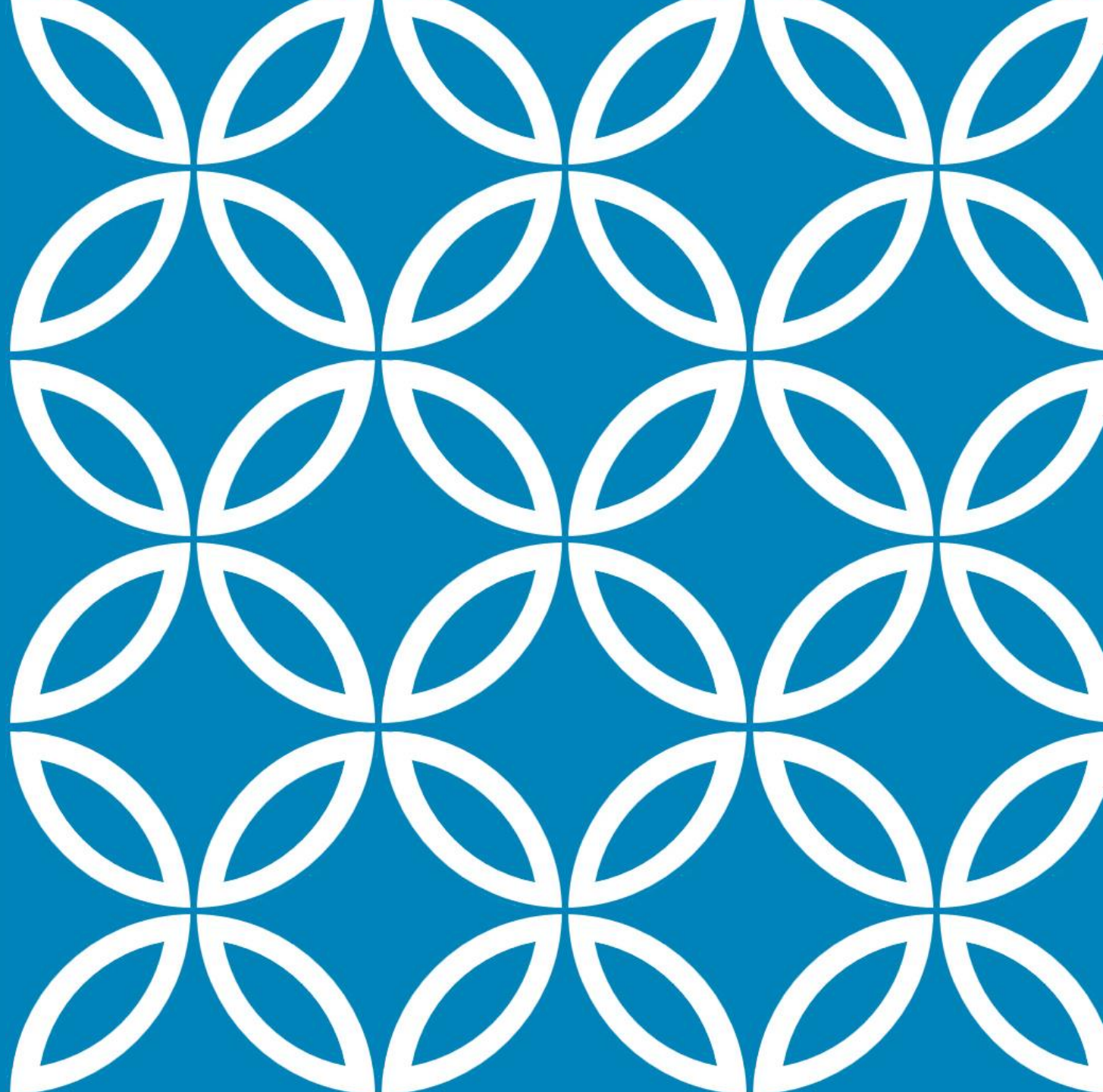

INTRODUCTION

- The Bible explains and normalizes the struggle of marriage.



SIN'S CAUSES

Instead of listening to Adam, Eve listened to Satan.

“Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, “Did God actually say, ‘You shall not eat of any tree in the garden?’”

Genesis 3:1

SIN'S CAUSES

Instead of listening to God, Adam listened to Eve.

“And to Adam He said, ‘Because you have listened to the voice of your wife and have eaten of the tree of which I commanded you, ‘You shall not eat.’”

Genesis 3:17

SIN'S CONSEQUENCES

The loss of security.

*Then the eyes of both were opened,
and they knew that they were naked.
And they sewed fig leaves together
and made themselves loincloths.*

Genesis 3:7

SIN'S CONSEQUENCES

The loss of unity.

The man said, “The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate.”

Genesis 3:12

SIN'S CONSEQUENCES

Eve's pain in childbearing, and tension in her role.

“I will surely multiply your pain in childbearing; in pain you shall bring forth children. Your desire shall be for your husband, and he shall rule over you.”

Genesis 3:16

SIN'S CONSEQUENCES

**Adam's pain in cultivation, and
the curse of death.**

*“...cursed is the ground because of
you; in pain you shall eat of it all the
days of your life...for you are dust,
and to dust you shall return.””*

Genesis 3:17-18

SIN'S CURE

The sacrifice and victory of Eve's offspring, Jesus Christ.

“I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.”

Genesis 3:15
