The primary way Mercy Street seeks to create these mentoring relationships is through its sports, mentoring, and leadership programs.

**Mercy Street Sports** is a primary outreach ministry in West and South Dallas. Serving nearly 1,500 kids annually, Mercy Street Sports strives to not only introduce kids to the Gospel, but to teach the fundamentals of a sport and fundamentals of the faith. Athletes are taught biblical values on the field so that they can put them into practice at home. Based on how these athletes respond, Mercy Street invites them into a mentoring relationship with their coach or another caring Christian adult.
